- Aur's Process -

Inner Circle 20

Welcome to 20! In this Advanced class, Vick and the Inner Circle group interview Aur to further understand how she reads Feng Shui in the way that she does.

Of course, the class takes an entirely different turn as we learn why Aur prioritizes the front door and how your garage can reveal whether you are stuck in the rat race or not.

Success is in the Details

One of the things that Aur does differently than all of us is in the amount of details that she looks into. In this class, we try to understand her thought process and how she relates the problem to her clients.

Although it is normal for humans to lie in order to save face, Feng Shui never lies. The worst part for humans is that they have maya and they don't even know they are lying to themselves.

If Aur says something that is true but they don't or can't admit to it her credibility is lost. When seeing Feng Shui for ourselves it's alright to be straightforward about everything and there is no necessity to pretend since that is the point of learning.

That said, when reading for others it's always important to be mindful of their feelings. So it's necessary to think of beautiful words to say in order for them to understand their problem. We must be mindful of their feelings as well. If they don't agree to what you say even if you are sure you are right, then it means you are not good enough.

For example, in the example we did in our last class. Do you remember Aur said the children will be spoiled by the parents. If she sees something like that in a house that she goes to consult, the first thing she would do is ask the child's age.

If they are below 5 years then she will mention that point. But if they are above 20 or 30, then she will not touch on that subject as some parents will then feel their children are not successful.

Let's say you know instantly that the man is having a mistress or that he is not able to perform, you can't simply walk in and confirm this fact. There is a way to relate this information, or at times it is not even necessary. Some people who are struggling financially don't like it when others think they are poor. Nor do they think of themselves as that.

If you are really interested in helping others you must learn to tell them in a way they understand and want to follow you.

The first thing she wants to find out when entering a home is how they enter. When walking in she will not ask any questions but she observes the area. At times the family will take her through the door they normally use but most often they take me through the front door even though they usually use the side door, since she is a guest.

Then she looks for other details like where the shoes are removed or the arrangement of the house which will show her which door is frequently used. So why do you think Aur concentrates on the front door so much? It shows her how to interact with the people in the home.

She will also look at the roof to get a rough idea on how they use their money.

Feng Shui Process

When walking up to a property you are reading, what is your process?

1. What does she do first?
2. What's the first thing important to know straight away?

Well, the first thing that Aur always notice is the entrance. Both the outside gate and the door to the house. Do you remember why?

Outside gate

It reveals how many wives the man has.

Entrance to the home

Next thing you must do is look out for the entrance. There are three ways in which people enter their homes. The way you enter will hold a different significance for the inhabitants.

1. Front Door
2. Side / Garage door.
3. Back Door

Front Door

When you walk in through the front door, it shows that the people living there are open-minded. They don't have an intention of hiding their actions. They don't care about what society thinks of them. It's easier talking to these people, however she would also take note of the day the person is born as well.

There are some houses that have a garage and they drive in, park their vehicle and close the garage door and walk in through the front entrance. Then there will be a subtle improvement in their life as time passes. They might not have any money when they first move in however as time passes - and if the colours and the numbers are not so bad - they will see an improvement in their life.

Side Door

Most others go in through the side/garage door and this too instantly reveals their personality. It shows that they are hiding their true self from society. They don't tell who they are or what they do. They are difficult to become friends with as well unless they become familiar with you.

Roller Doors

People who have large roller gates in their homes reveal they will have to work all their life.

Why is this read this way?

These types of large gates were usually used for factories. And there they have a driver or a security guard to open and close the door. But, in a house it means you have to open and close the doors.

If you use this entrance to go in and out of the house everyday, you will be a slave to yourself. It will be a life full of suffering because you wake up early in the morning and go to work, come back home extremely tired and everyday you have to worry about how you will manage for the next month.

You won't have enough savings to be free. And when you lose money, you lose a big lump because it's a huge door that opens. Many westerners have lives like this. Even if they have a gigantic house, they have a life where they suffer.

Except

If they are rich enough to have a driver who would open and close the doors.

If the bread winner goes in and out through the roller gates and others use the front door will it affect only one person?

It will affect both because they are connected.

Does this mean that it is recommended to use the front door?

Yes it is so if you don't want your life to continue suffering.

Back Door

However, if they park their car and walk to the house through the back door, then it means you will be an employee all your life. You will always have a salary and not own anything.

Missing Sectors

It's very difficult to fix the positions because it's the nature of the world. However, if there is a missing area in the house you can regain that area by creating a balance.

Parking Space in the Girl Area

If a house has a garage in the little girl area and the vehicle drives in there that couple will not be able to have a girl baby in that house while living there - unless they had a girl before they moved in.

Improving an Area

Aur once saw Feng Shui for one of her students where he had started decorating a garden with rocks in the man's area. Unintentionally he was improving that position by making it so beautiful and giving it more importance.

What do you think happened? As he took more care of the man area this area became more improved. This made him more selfish and he started thinking of himself.

Destroying an Area

Another thing that can happen is when you make a position so important that no one uses it. This will destroy that position. For example, Aur knew a family that made the man area very special and important. It was reserved only for their ancestors and was never or rarely used. This destroyed that area.

Missing Area

If there is a patio in the man area instead of a building it is read completely differently. It shows that the man of the house will be just like an ornament. He will not do anything unless asked to. He will be just like a decoration.

Majority of the women won't care about it if the guy comes home and be like a doll. They won't mind it at all and they will just leave them alone.

Will it help if we use the teenage area more? Can that help the man area?

No. You can't do that but you can make the patio more useful. This will help the man be more useful. Make that position more useful in order for it to make the man more important again.

It would be great if you could spend some time decorating it. It's better than having an unused space. Make it an important area for yourself. It's the same thing, when you make an area a storage area or a shed as well. Although that place is used to keep things, that place gets destroyed when humans don't use it.

Let's use some examples to see what details she would look into when reading a house.

Example 1



As soon as Aur sees this the first thing she can say about this house is that this house is on the mortgage.

Roller-Gate

Since the gate is a big roller gate we can see the people in this house will have a lot of suffering in their life because they can't stop working.

Slope

This picture seems as if it is on a natural hill. Even though the house is lower than the road, you can't read it like you would read a house in a flat land. We have mentioned before that if the house is lower than the road, then we say they will never improve in life. In this situation you can't read like that because the house is built on a hill.

From the road, there is a small mount and then it goes under. It's like a collection spot. This means they keep their money. They don't spend unnecessarily.

Floor Plan



Destroying An Area

When you see the floor plan you can see that everything is managed by the man in this house. Aur reads this because the house is the man area. The garage and spa which is not usually used by humans are in the woman area. This destroys that area. The house and the useful areas are in the man area.

Since the spa and the garage is on the woman's side the woman has to be careful with the emotions. The spa is water and water represents emotions and if there is water in that area, it also shows that it is emotionally up and down. There is also the possibility of the inhabitants getting sick.

Rooms

The bedroom is in the Number 2 position and this shows you can see that their emotions are not stable. The family lounge is in the young boys area and this means they don't spend any family time together. The position of the wardrobe shows that the people living here don't care what others think.

Toilet

The toilet is parallel to the road which means he will be careful of what he spends. He doesn't share it with anyone nor does he make it so comfortable. He thinks before he gives money to someone.

Entrance

The front door is hidden by trees and bushes and this means nothing. The porch in front again shows that the father is controlling everything and everyone.

Example 2



Roof

The roof in this picture has a lot of triangles right which shows us that the people in this house are specialists in something. However they will lead a private life. They don't share anything with others. This can be read due to the multiple triangles which all represent fire.

Gutter

There is no gutter around the roof which means the water will go everywhere. This shows us that they use their own money without thinking. It's not controlled. However, since the rain falls into the garden it also shows that they use the money for their own individual pleasure. They don't think it will benefit the family as a whole but everyone uses it for their personal benefit.

Garden

With the garden, you'll must learn the integration between the plants.

1. Which tree will help which plant to grow.
2. Which tree will kill the pests coming to destroy the plants.
3. Which plants will attract the bugs and butterflies.

However, there is one piece of advice that I can give you. Plant trees around the house that give you a fragrance. It doesn't matter even if the tree is not beautiful but if the flower has a nice smell it means the angels will come and visit. Plants and fruits will bring in a lot of poison.

Esthar has visited Aur's house and she must have noticed that Aur doesn't have a flower garden. She has something that looks like a forest. With many trees and leaves that has fallen down. Mature trees will help each other to survive.



Trees

With trees, you have a root system, and given enough time about three years, the roots underneath the ground will become like a net, and thus maintain or support the earth so that it doesn't sink.

We have learnt before that if we lose earth or if it sinks it shows that life is going down. Whereas if it supports it or the root system holds it up, it shows that your life will improve where you are right now. It's like a support net.

Moat

Aur has water all around the edge of the property. It's like a water capture area because she doesn't want the water from her property to flow out into the government system or the water facility.

She doesn't want to pay unnecessary tax. Water represents money and Aur has made it in such a way that the water is collected back in tanks that help a lot of houses in the village. This shows that she will be paying much less to the government and will be able to maintain more money. Every year Aur has tractors come over and basically deepens the moat.

Home-Work

Next Class we can learn how you read people just by looking at the way people dress, talk, act, and think. However, before that there is homework for you to do. Write down what you think of the following and whatever you write will show who you really are. We will use those examples in the next class to show how communication and how writing shows our personalities.

1. Dress

Do you dress for others to see or because you like it. How do you pick your dress? Do you pick it up because you like it or because it makes you look good. Or because the social say that this is something that you have to wear.

2. Talk

Do you talk from your own feelings or from others perspective? What kind of talk and what is the result you want? Is it for yourself or for others?

3. Act

Do you act depending on emotion? Or do you act depending on other people? Do you act because the social expect you to act like that.

4. Think

You think of other people's emotions or you think for yourself.

When you say that you love that person, do you think for yourself or do you think for them. Give reasons with examples and not out of thin air. If you say, I think for other people you must explain how. If you say you love your husband you shouldn't mind if he goes out with another woman. Will you accept it? Technically, we don't want him to have another person because of ourselves. Then how can you say you love him?

Climate - Geography - Culture



A

This house is situated on a hill and it is going down. So we will be reading Feng Shui totally differently than normal.



D

This house is in Greece and it is on an Island. Then The Feng Shui is again seen very differently. You will have wind coming in that will have salt.



H

The building with the pointing roof shows that you will pressure yourself too much. Aur doesn't recommend living in a house like that. Your actions will depend on what society will think of you.

It's like number 1 a fire with an extreme fire. This is the kind of building for a palace or a rich peoples house. It means you are pressuring yourself too much. The layers of the buildings show that there are a lot of people depending on you.

This house is in Indonesia and the people here will suffer because their community has a lot of hierarchy very much like Indians.



C

This building is in Singapore. The code number for Singapore is +65. Although they think they have a lot of freedom it's only maya.

The people living in Singapore have a life that suffers. They will be very much in a frame. They can't own anything nor can they depend on themselves. They have to work all their life.

They can't do anything and nothing in the world is complete for them. All the buildings in Singapore are like that.

If you build like this in japan it will be all destroyed because of the earthquakes. Although you'll live on the island you'll don't make use of the area. You'll make a hole and there are missing parts. Here too, There will be a few selected people who will be rich, and then there is a large population of people who suffer.
