

Feng Shui Positions

Welcome to class 4!

If you want to be a part of the examples in class 7 and 8 please send us the floor plan of the building and the land. If you want Aur to be 100% accurate make sure you send us the exact measurements. Remember that if your proportions are wrong, then the reading will also be wrong.

Before we delve into today's lesson there is something for you which we promised from last class.

Kerri

Last class Kerri said that her bedroom position was in #3, but according to that information, Aur's reading was not accurate.

So we asked Kerri to send in her floorplan, which you can see here on the right.

The outline represents her property's border.

She sleeps in the bedroom at the back left of the property. The blue bar shows what side of the bed she sleeps on.

As we know, the last class she said that her bedroom was in the #3 position.

She was correct about the #3 position - for the building. But, when looking at the whole land she is close to #4 as well (can you see that?)

The other thing to consider is where she sleeps.



Since she sleeps on the right-hand side, she will have influence from the #2 area more than #3. Her partner, sleeping on the left-hand side, will be more influence by the #3 position.

(Remember last time we said that the side the bed you sleep on shows which position will influence you the most)

So.

When reading how the positions will influence Kerri, we need to take into account that it will a blend of the #4 area (land) #3 area (building), #2 area (side of bed and bed position in room).

When Aur teaches the characteristics of a position, those are the pure forms of the positions.

For example, when she explains characteristics of the #3 area, they are the pure characteristics of that area, as if the person is in the #3 area of the room, in the #3 area of the building, in the #3 area of the land.

But, in real-life, people don't usually stay or live in pure positions. They will be mix of different areas of influence.

It takes practice, but you need to learn to put them together and read it precisely.

Aur`s Analysis using Kerri`s Floorplan

Kerri will be detailed oriented but doesn't talk much.

When at home, if she asks someone a favor or to help her and they don't do it, she will tend to keep quiet and do it herself rather than start an argument.

The influence of #4 shows that she won't have a lot of time to spare or she won't be in the room all the time.

She won't go to bed at one particular time although she tries to.

Because, although the #3 influence says that she will want to go to bed at the same time, the truth of her being in the #4 area (land) shows that she won't.

Sickness

Because she has influences from #2, #3, and #4 together, she will have stomach and muscle problems. Although she isn't aware of it herself, she stresses herself out a lot. This causes her to often experience brain fog. She also has problems with her short-term memory.

From the positions, Aur reads that - even though Kerri is stressed – Kerri will claim that she isn't stressed. This is because it's the woman position (#3).

Women want to show to everyone that they are strong, and important, and have a lot of responsibility. A woman will only allow herself to look weak with the people closest to her.

This knowledge is detailed and in-depth.

You can expect more examples like this in classes 7 and 8. Right now we are only looking on the surface.

We still need to look into each individual room and see how it affects us. On top of that, there are still many more details to look at.

For example:

If you have done the Taksa or Feng Shui Color course with us, you know that you can use the color of the bed sheets to change your life too.

Right not, just using the positions, it cannot be 100% accurate because Aur doesn't know the date of birth, or Kerri's address. Likewise, the proportions of the picture might not be 100% accurate.

So, if you want it to be 100% accurate and you want guaranteed accuracy, you need to actually be there with all the information available.

Class 4: Bathroom and Kitchen

The Bathroom

- Your bathroom represents your spending habits
- It reveals your hygiene routine too

If a bathroom is connected to your bedroom, it reveals how you spend money on yourself. Because this is the bathroom you personally use. Whereas the bathroom in your guestroom or in more public areas of your home which could be used by guests will show how you spend your money socially.

This is similar in businesses.

A staff toilet will be read differently to a customer toilet for example.

Some companies may want their staff to spend all their money so the employees will be with the same company for the long term.

Note

Always keep in mind that Feng Shui is only 20% of your life. The other 80% is made up of your own behavior or actions.

When you see something in your house that you don't like, watch yourself when it comes to that associated action.

So...

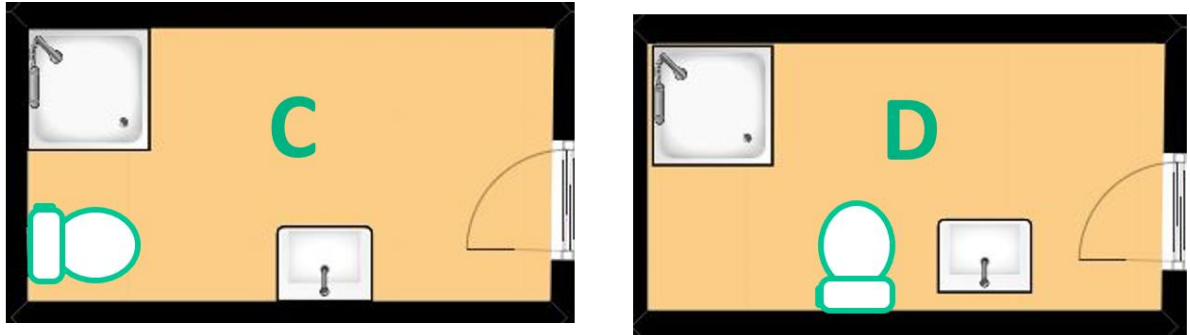
If the positions reveal that you will spend your money on unnecessary things, you can practice being self-aware and refrain from buying things you won't use.

The whole point of learning Feng Shui is to become more aware of the influences your surroundings have on your actions and to use that knowledge and your own actions to develop ourselves.

Parallel vs. Perpendicular

Parallel

If your toilet is parallel to the road when you are sitting down (like in picture C) it means that you will be able to manage your money until the end of the month.



Perpendicular

If your toilet is perpendicular to the road, that is facing towards or away from the road then it means you are going to have trouble keeping money each month. You will have trouble saving money.

This is very important piece of knowledge in Aur's method of feng shui. It is something which we have taught a lot.

Every position or the location of the toilet in the house will show you how you spend money. The side the toilet faces show you waste or manage the money properly.

Remember

There is nothing purely right or wrong in real Feng Shui. Everything depends on what you want. For example, if you want your customers to spend money in your shop, make sure that the toilet your customer toilet is perpendicular to the road. But, if you want to keep money – say for examples at home - your toilet should be parallel.

Fixing the fix

If your toilet is perpendicular like D, but you want to keep money:

You can put a U-shaped mat under the toilet.

But, if your toilet is facing to the road like C, and you want to manage money, don't use a U-shaped rug. You can however use any other shaped rug.

When picking the color to use for the rug, that's something we teach in the Feng Shui Color class.

Next time you are in a hotel or restaurant, look to see which way the toilets are facing and watch your spending habits while there. The best position for a hotel room toilet when you travel is the perpendicular (surprised?), that's because the whole reason for traveling is to spend money and to enjoy yourself. It would be annoying to go on vacation and not find anything to spend your money on or when you go shopping that you don't find the right size or the color you like, right?

There was a resort in an island that Aur once visited where the toilet was parallel to the road.


The problem for her was that there was nothing to do. Although the only place to eat was at the hotel, Aur never felt hungry and ended up only eating once a day.

Connecting the bathrooms with the positions

Bathroom in the #1

Spending habits

- Uses money in large amounts
- Buys new and up to date items
- Always wants the best or the highest quality
- Doesn't care about price tags
- Likes to show off their possessions

Usually people with a toilet in this area buy things to show off. They see themselves as smart and up-to-date. When they buy something, they often can't decide which color or style they want so they end up buying different colors or styles of the same thing.

Bathroom behavior

- Spends a lot of time in the bathroom
- Likes to read, play games, check emails or just sit and think there.
- Won't be tidy but will keep the room clean

Someone with a toilet in this position you will tend to think for a long time but make quick decisions when necessary.

They want to be number one in everything.

If your bathroom is here and you want to buy a computer for example, you'll look around before buying. However, if a friend comes along and talks about how he's going to buy a new computer, you will immediately feel the need to buy one before he does.

You want to be on the spot. Everything has to be perfect.

If your bathroom is here, you will buy things without thinking and end up using your "future money" which means you will likely be in debt.

Normally when you use credit cards, you stop to think if you can pay the money back. But, in this position you will not think like that.

You should also consider the way the toilet is facing and also the day of the week a person is born when looking at the bathroom.

Usually people don't have a toilet in this position. Instead they'll have a bedroom in this position. If you have a toilet here, it's likely to be an ensuite for a bedroom like often seen in larger homes.


Anecdote:

There was a singer I knew whose toilet was in this position. He once went shopping for a new bag and found something he liked, a \$10,000 bag. But, he couldn't decide on which color to get. So he ended up getting four in different colors.

The Bathroom in the #2

Spending habits

- Others don't agree or understand their spending preferences.
- Indecisive when shopping.
- When they like something they buy a lot of it.
- Buys things to make them feel good.
- Shops for things they feel show who they are.

Unlike the #1 position where you have trouble choosing the colors, a person with a bathroom in the #2 position will end up buying a lot of the same thing.

People with the bathroom in this area are specific for the things that they like. If they like something they will buy a lot of it. For example, if they find good socks, they will buy a dozen pairs.

They don't care what society thinks is trendy. They will wear what they like and their own style.

Bathroom behavior

- Spends a lot of time in the bathroom
- No one knows what they do in there.
- It all depends on their mood.


There are times you will use the bathroom so fast that people are shocked how you can come out so fast and other times they take so long people wonder what they are doing in there.

Since westerners don't have maids so you will end up cleaning it. But you will clean only when you feel like it. There won't be a routine.

The bathroom in the #3

Spending habits

- Buys anything on sale
- Usually buys anything that is on sale
- Shops for things for the house and others
- Never just buys 1 thing
- People living here likely to have a nicely decorated home with knick knacks

People with their toilets in this area buy things that aren't useful. BUT, the person shopping will think that it is useful.

For example:

You know you will be giving away a lot of gifts for the New Year, so you buy nice things for other people with the intention of giving them away. The problem is you keep buying things so often and putting them away that you forget what you've already bought and for who.

Bathroom behavior


- Uses the bathroom often but doesn't linger.
- Bathroom will be immaculate
- Everything is in its place

If you stay in the bathroom for a long time, it's because you are cleaning up. Your initial intention might have been to take a shower, but then you notice something that is dirty, or not organized, so you end up spending more time in there, cleaning. You didn't plan to do it, but you still do it anyway.

The Bathroom in the #4

Spending habits

- Buys "Trendy" things.
- When their friends have something, they want it too.
- Spends money on anything "feminine".
- Buys things they may never even use
- Never shops alone. Loves to be with others.

Shopping is a social occasion when your bathroom is in this position. When your friends buy something, even if you don't have money or don't like it, you still feel like buying the same thing they did, anyway. This position makes you want to follow another lead.

If you are a loner without friends to influence your thoughts, you will not be able you come to a conclusion as what you want to buy. You will feel like buying one thing, then decide against it, walk past, then come back to it and feel like buying it all over again. You will go through these steps repeatedly until the object is obsolete.


Bathroom behaviors

- Never tidy but feels that everything "has its place"
- Will know if anything is moved or taken
- Spends time making themselves look good
- Doesn't spend much time on the toilet or shower
- Even if somebody takes something that you don't use every day you will know that it is gone.

The Bathroom in the #5

Spending habits

- Loves spending money on little things.
- Don't think when shopping.
- Buys things from their appearance.
- Always something wrong with what they buy.
- Gets anything that makes them feel special.

The weakness in this position is that when you want to buy something, you try to come up with your own reasoning to make you feel good about your decision to buy something. However, these "reasons" are often just to support your feelings, they might not always be logical.

Always imagine the real character when trying to figure out these positions. In this case, although a little girl believes that what she thinks is logical, important, and right, doesn't mean it's so.

People in this position like to purpose things for their family and friends but it will be from their own perspective and not what others like.

Bathroom behavior

- Bathroom clean but untidy
- Won't think while in there
- Don't spend much time there


Their mind will be blurry like little girls. They keep looking for things that they have misplaced. Even if they want to spend time in the bathroom there they won't.

Special note - this is usually the case with most positions in the front. If you have a bedroom in the front and want to relax there always will be something that will wake you up. It doesn't matter how late you go to bed.

The Bathroom in the #6

Spending habits

- Buys things others would never have thought of.
- Always buys things they have to customize
- Indecisive about what to buy
- Selfish. Only buys things for themselves
- Gets whatever they like no matter what others say.
- Private about their money.

Lots of people don't have a bathroom in here. When you buy something others will say it is obsolete and tell you that there is no point in buying, but they will end up using it too.

You think you are buying for your own needs but in truthfully, that's not the case. Others will end up using whatever you buy instead.

Although you think that it is your money and you want to save it, some needs will arise where you will have to spend money on others. In this position you won't be able to keep money, even if you want to.

Bathroom behavior

- Won't get used much
- People won't think to clean
- Bathroom often gets forgotten.


Even when you do clean it, people will think that you didn't. Every time people use it they will make it dirty again and mess everything up.

It's a very poor position.

The Bathroom in the #7

Spending habits

- Likely to get in debt.
- Spontaneous when shopping.
- Often buys things they never use.
- Gets bored quickly with whatever they buy.
- Always want something they don't have.

You never think whether you can afford something or not. If you see a phone better than what you have you'll sell your phone for whatever you get for it and buy a new one with added debt.

It is impossible to have a toilet here, except in a condominium. This is a very difficult for someone with a bathroom in the pure 7 area to get rich because it is hard for them to manage or plan their money.

Bathroom behavior


- Don't like spending time here.
- In and out
- Not tidy and not clean

The people in this position will be careless when there, often leaving the light on or forgetting to flush the toilet.

The Bathroom in the #8

Spending habits

- Buys things to impress others.
- Uses their money to show off.
- Always buys to impress others.
- Use their money to show off.
- Always buys according to the latest trend.
- Loves buying technical gizmos.
- Buys whatever they think is fun.
- Spends money on entertainment.

It's not like in #1 where you want to show off to other people. Here it is for you to look cool. #1 is for status. #8 is to be cool, interesting and unique.

They consider the latest trends according to their social group, not what the world thinks. These people will be the first people to buy a fidget spinner, or download Pokemon Go, or try to make themselves addicted to the latest trend. They try to make themselves "different".


Bathroom behavior

- Doesn't spend much too much time in the bathroom
- Tidy but doesn't clean often

The bathroom in the #9

Spending habits

- Always spending money on other people.
- Gives money to family or pays for them.
- Whenever has money, uses it.
- Spending habits are a mix of everything.
- Habits change every day.

If your bathroom is here, you will never buy the same things every time. One day it'll be something big, the next it will be 20 small things.

The position is sad, because it means that you will buy for others but nobody appreciates you. You will feel like “I bought this for you, and you didn’t have to pay for it”.

But, even if you buy something that really nice for someone else, they’ll feel like “Yeah, so what?”

Bathroom behavior

- Used often by everyone in the house.
- Won’t stay in there long because doesn’t like being alone.
- Messy, but no one wants to clean it. “Not mine”.

***Remember** technology has changed Feng Shui interpretations. If it says that you must be with people, it could now mean you are with people - on social media. So even though the front areas mean that you can’t stay there for a long time, you may be able to now, but your mind will be somewhere else using your phone or ipad.

Also, because the #7 position is social, so people could sit on the toilet here for a long time while chatting to their friends on facebook or Whatsapp.

This toilet the people will feel like I never have my own life. I always have to do things for others, But, when they are in the bathroom they finally feel like it is their area, their life. And, it’s the only time they have for themselves.

Question

Even if you have your toilet parallel to the e road, could you still use all your money each month?

Answer

The position or direction of your toilet doesn’t show whether you spend money or not. It’s whether you will spend it on useful things and whether you will be able to manage your spending habits.

The Kitchen and Dining Room

- The kitchen represents family
- It Reveals eating habits
- And, Shows a person's dining habits

Kitchen/Cooking Area:

- Shows the what kind of food you have
- How you cook.


Dining Area:

- Shows your behavior when are sitting down.
- What kind of conversation you have at the dinner table
- Whether you spend time together or by yourself
- If you go there at the same time as others in your family

The kitchen in the #1

Family dynamics

- Very close family.
- Loud and fun.
- Spends lot of time together.
- Argues often but it never lasts long.

Dining habits

- Eats big meals
- Loves variety
- Not worried about how something looks
- Cooks a lot

Aur's family kitchen is in this position and when her mum cooks she cooks as if she is going to feed the whole village. when they eat they have petty fights with each other. It is so much fun. We usually use our hands and not use the fork and spoon. We don't care about how we look.

This position shows that you will cook a lot and if there is only one person living in this house it shows that you won't use this kitchen that much.

A refrigerator in this area will make you buy a lot. You won't be able to eat it and it will all rot. If you have a big family it will be easy.

Always think about everything and analyze what the person's individual situation and how it will interact with this influence.

Question - Why is there a difference between the readings in the same position if it is in the building and the land? Outside verses inside

Out of the whole land, it is going to be a pure #1 but if it is in the house it sometimes will not be pure. Even if the kitchen is #1 inside the house you all know that it is a law everywhere in the world that there is always a small space left when a house is built. That's why Aur reads differently.

If you have barbeque you look only from the barbeque stuff. But in the kitchen you have to look at the refrigerator sink, microwave. Everything in detail. This also shows the interaction with


different objects. You have to see how a person interacts with the fridge. Where is it in the land, in the room or in the building?

You will have to read it differently if it is a big outdoor area. Outdoor means you are going to use it only when there is a lot of people. Not when there is one person. But if it is in the house it will be different

Family dynamics

- Everyone has their own lives
- Don't spend much time together in the house
- Pleasant but individually private

Dining habits

- Never eats in a routine
- Only cooks when they are in the mood

Family dynamics

- Formal and disciplined
- Has to look good "maintain appearances"
- Polite and well mannered with each other.

Dining habits

- Have routine around meals and mealtime.
- Eats everything for a reason.

- Likes formal table manners and settings.
- Everyone must look good.

Here you will not be able to eat the food according to what you like. Instead, you eat everything for a reason. There should be proteins, carbohydrates and everything that is good and healthy for you in each meal.

- Each person keeps to themselves.
- Avoids talking about personal issues with family.
- Keeps family and social life separate.

Dining habits

- Uses the room everyday
- Eats the same food all the time
- Doesn't like to have guests over (private, remember?)

The best thing that you can do to study is that you can look at the rooms over and over again, try to figure out the similarities in the positions. Try observing the commonalities and the patterns that keep repeating. .


We know teenage girls like their privacy. She wants this space for herself. Each person in this family will keep to themselves.

Aur calls this position the crocodile tongue because they like to eat the same food repeatedly.

The kitchen in the #5

Family dynamics

- Everyone has their own lives
- Close emotionally.
- Highly independent.

Dining habits.

- Rarely uses the kitchen for cooking
- Goes out to eat
- More often to make coffee or small things than cook
- Usually don't finish everything in their plate.

Usually in #5, #6, #7 positions you will usually have your meals outside. If you do have them inside it will be a sandwich or a salad or something that you will have to put in the microwave and heat it up. It won't be good food.

Again, anything in the front of the building shows that you will not spend a lot of time in there. You go in and out. It is the same with the kitchen. You are not going to sit in there and cook a roast.

Aur` s Kitchen Feng Shui Tip

When Aur goes travelling with her students, she orders food by looking at where the kitchens is situated. She is always correct because she knows.

A kitchen in the front of a restaurant will only taste good if you are going to order a salad. Look at where the kitchen is next time you go out. See if the style of food is aligned with the style of the kitchen.

If you want to eat a roast meal, make sure you go to a place where the kitchen is in the #1 position. Then you know they will cook everything slowly and thoroughly. Because, the #1 position, will be very detailed with fire.

Family Dynamics

- Only talk to each other when fighting
- Not close to each other when at home
- Don't spend time together

Dining habits

- Hardly cook at home, if ever
- Eats for nourishment, not pleasure.

Family dynamics

- Talkative and friendly with each other
- Loves to talk about themselves
- Playful
- Don't tend to fight. When they do, its big.

Dining habits

- Food either looks good and lacks flavor, or looks bad but tastes great

- Never sticks to recipes
- Eats bland foods
- Fast eaters

- Loves spending time together
- Straight forward and blunt with each other
- Openly share with each other.

- Try things others wouldn't
- Likes to have guests over for meals.

Even though they are likely to have people over for dinner, nobody is going to go out of their way to serve the guests. They will be asked to serve themselves and made to feel at home. Usually restaurants have the kitchen in this area. The food tastes ok. Not overly great.

- You will cook a lot and it will be different things every day.

Question

If you are in the catering business, is this a good position for the kitchen?

Answer

For a kitchen it is a good position, but not for storage. If you have storage here, you'll end up buying too many things which will eventually rot.

And you have a store room here whatever that goes in never comes out.

#9 Specialty

Everything in the 9 position must involve multiple people. You will not do anything alone in this area. So, if you live alone and your kitchen is in the 9 area, you will not eat at home. You will eat someplace else.

Whereas, if your bedroom is here, it would be difficult for you to go to bed at night. You want someone here with you.
