Each number, representing an element, is connected to a different area of your life.

When understanding how to read this, you can know great depths of any person.

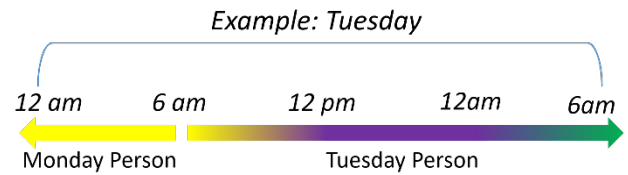
Your Birthday

The day of the week you were born determines what your Taksa grid looks like and where each of the 8 elements are in your life.

Your time of Birth

The time you were born affects how we read our Taksa grid. If you were born before 6 am, you use the Taksa grid from the day BEFORE the "day" you were born.

What time were you born?



Example: If you were born Tuesday at 3 am, you're a Monday person and you should use the Monday Taksa grid.

However, it's like color shading, the closer you are to a different day, the more influence you will have of their personality within you. So, if you were born at 7am, you have strong influences from the day before's grid too.

NOTE: If you are reading a person and it doesn't seem accurate. Check their birthday!

The Taksa Grid Boxes. Each of the 8 outside boxes on the grid represent a different area of your life and have a name.

No matter what day of the week you are looking at, the position of the boxes and their meaning do not change. But the numbers do.

So for each day of the week, the person will have a different number within their "Boriwan" box for example, but they will all have a "Boriwan" box on the top left as you see it in the image.

The Box meanings.

The box names comes from Bali Sanskrit words and each have their own meaning.

Boriwan means those you are responsible for.

This includes the person themselves, their friends, staff, colleagues, children and pets. It can also include their husband or wife if they are the one who takes care of the other person.

So whenever you want to know or understand more about how a person will act in regular day to day society, or with their friends, children or staff (as a boss), you can look at this area of their grid.

RU means health, mind, feeling.

It includes thoughts, dreams, feeling, imagination, sickness, health and even how you die.

This is where you can look to understand a person's feelings, their mind, how they think and their motivations. It also shows you what is good and bad for your health.

Deat means power.

This box includes a person's influence, how they try to control others, how they lead, command or charm others. It also shows how they are when they are angry. If someone is a sales person, this will also be their style of selling.

This box in the grid will show you everything about these areas of a person's personality.

Sri means stability

Stability includes everything that they feel they can count on to remain there for them in their life. This includes their family, their long term relationships, their career and anything else that makes them feel secure.

Most of Aur's students misuse Sri. They always want to use their Sri, but the thing about Sri is that it means stable. So if you are poor, you will remain stable in being poor. It won't create change in your life, only maintain whatever is there. It's good to use if you're already successful.

Look at this area of the grid when you want to know more about a person's personality in their workplace or with their family etc.

Moola means trade

You can look at this box when you want to know more about how you or another person sees trade. What their motivations are when trading anything the person sees of value.

For example, how they spend money, what their expectations are in give and get scenarios, etc.

But remember, Moola is give AND take. It's never one way.

Usaha means patience/action

This box include all areas of a person's personality around how they take action. It represents their physical behavior, their hobbies, patterns of action, habits, how they act naturally without thinking. Such as a reaction. It also represent discipline, patience and a person's part – time job if they have one.

You would look at this box if you want to know any area like this of a person's life. For example, the patterns of how they like to do things. Some people like going step by step and need structure, whereas others are better being spontaneous. That's something you can see in this area of the grid.

Montree means support

Montree represents anyone who supports you or who is higher than you. People you need in your life. This includes your superiors/bosses, parents, clients, teachers, guardian angels and mentor. Even people you look to for advice will be within your Montree.

This is where you can see how a person will act towards these people, how they will act with their superiors, and whether or not people help them or if they like to do things themselves – as is the case with people born certain days of the week.

Kalakini means shadow

Kalakini means the bad side of you but it's not really the bad side of you. It's just what in your mind means the bad side. It also represents the side of you that you don't like others to see. It could also be called your subconscious self. It also represent loss and weakness.

This is where to look when you want to know a person's natural weaknesses, who they are underneath it all. Perhaps even in ways that they aren't even aware of themselves.

In the end, the Kalakini is who we are for real.

Quick note. Most people love their Kalakini color. As humans we all tend to like things that are not good for us, including the colors we choose.

Example for each Day

Now, keep in mind:

With all of these examples, the way they are read is as follows:

The number's meaning (for example 1 – King) is connected to the box's meaning (for example Boriwan – you, your children etc.)

This way, imagine the archetype personality in that situation. This is how Aur gets the answer she provides each time. By simply asking the question “how would ___ act in ___ way”.

For example:

How would a King act with his children? Which is the answer Aur provides with Sunday.

When we get to the other boxes in future weeks, we will look at different scenarios. So how would a King think, how would a housewife think, how would a soldier think? Etc...

Sunday

Keep in mind that this person has the character of “King flame” in their Boriwan (meaning themselves, their children etc).

Whoever born Sunday will act try to look good (as a king would). They gonna act like they know everything on earth.

When they are with friends they want to go to good restaurants and nice looking everything but when by themselves they will eat anything.

When with their children or pets. They just want to look good on the surface. But other than that they don't take not that much. They won't be very detail oriented with their children or pets.

Monday

Monday people with the housewife (2) in their Boriwan will have lots of friends to chit chat with (imagine again a housewife).

They go into other people's business and are good at consulting or giving advice. But their emotion is up and down. They can be angel but they can also be like a devil.

They're also the kind of people who will remember everything you do for a long time (like a woman)

With their children, they're easy to be cranky. When the kid does something bad it will make them pissed quickly. They won't teach the child in a proper way. They will get annoyed or frustrated quickly instead of teaching their kid.

Tuesday has the number 3 in their Boriwan. So it means they will be very deep or specialist in something that they love.

But this people also have their own discipline or own frame or routine. When something is out of their frame they have for themselves it's very difficult for them to handle or accept it.

They say they love their friends but only on the surface. Most people born on Tuesday are like slaves for their family. No one force them. They do it by themselves, they feel like it's their responsibility. Their whole motivation is their duty or responsibility. "I Have to"

Wednesday

Even though they are detailed people they still can't be organized. They love things to be organized but they can't do it themselves. They often love shows or books to show how to organize but they can't organize their lives.

With their children, they will let others take responsibility for their children. For example you will ask your husband or wife to help them take care of the kids.

Because Vick's phone number starts with Sri, meaning stability, it means that he usually uses the phone in the same way every time. Then followed by Boriwan meaning self and friends, it means that he will normally use this phone for talking with his friends.

77 Two moola shows that when people call him, they want something from him – trade.

Then the 4 and 8 kusatru pair shows that whatever you expect will happen, wont.

But, because it's sri – stability and Montree – support. That means that when Vick asks for support or help with something he won't get it.
